If selected as the ACA's representative, you'll have the chance to take part in CLF fundraising activities, attend events, be a flag bearer at presentations, and so much more!

WE ARE SEEKING A YOUNG WOMAN BETWEEN THE AGE OF 20-25 WHO:

- Works well within a team, showing team spirit, dedication, and a genuine commitment to the growth and development of their peers and the sport of campdrafting into the future.
- Understands that leadership isn't always about being in the spotlight — sometimes it's about working behind the scenes, even on the smaller tasks that help everything run smoothly.
- Supports CLF fundraising activities, particularly through selling Monster Raffle, Lottery Tickets and CLF merchandise and assisting at the Nutrien Classic event (independent fundraising by entrants is not required).
- Is innovative, determined, and inspired to raise not only funds but also awareness of CLF Charities — sharing how contributions make a positive difference in the lives of those we support.
- Demonstrates potential to be an active committee member or future leader, showing passion for progress, sportsmanship, and making meaningful contributions to our industry.
- Brings creativity, initiative, and commitment, while also collaborating effectively, listening to others, and working toward shared outcomes.
- Recognises and manages conflicts of interest, always putting the greater good of the group first.
- Shows adaptability — able to think on their feet, embrace change, and find practical solutions when plans shift, especially during a live event like Nutrien.
- Offers fresh ideas, new perspectives, and a willingness to help CLF grow and evolve.
- Maintains confidentiality and understands when discretion is required.
- Can comfortably interact with people of all ages and backgrounds, contributing to a welcoming and positive community spirit.
- May not yet be a confident public speaker, but is willing to give it a go and grow those skills.
- Is open to pushing personal boundaries, meeting new people, and stepping outside their comfort zone for the benefit of others.
- Shows commitment to their Quest entry and the compulsory activities involved.
- Prepares in advance for the responsibilities of the role, demonstrating good time management, organisation, and multitasking skills.
- Understands the importance of animal welfare and how public perception of our industry can shape its future.
- Shows potential to inspire and mentor other young women, encouraging them to step forward and take part in opportunities like the Young Ambassador Quest.





Entrant's Expected Activities



Volunteer Work

- Prior to the Nutrien Classic Event - minimum of 2 hours at a campdraft or other community event (may be verified by CLF).

Promotion and Community Engagement

- Prior to the Nutrien Classic Event - promote CLF and its charities at local campdrafts or other events (at entrant's discretion).
- (e.g. community events, local campdrafts, online promotion, awareness stalls, public speaking, social media).

Attend Judging Panel Interview

Topics may include:

- Entrant's experiences during the Quest.
- Future direction of campdrafting.
- Industry improvements.
- Animal welfare issues and impacts on the industry.
- Knowledge of at least one CLF Nutrien charities.

Event Attendance and Duties

- Compulsory attendance at the Nutrien Classic in Tamworth (usually Wednesday to Sunday morning).
- Perform official CLF duties as required.
- Attend and assist with flag bearing practice sessions and participate in flag-bearing as required. Please note - flag bearing is subject to entrant and their horse's suitability.
- Attend YAQ Awards Presentation - usually held last Sunday morning.
- Attend rostered or scheduled CLF events during the Nutrien Classic.
- Wear sashes during official duties and when assisting at the CLF promotional stand at the Nutrien Classic.

Re-entry Rule

A 12-month break is required before re-entering. Previous winner and runner up are not eligible to re-enter.

Cost

- Travel, accommodation and AELEC fees are the entrant's responsibility. However, ACA's Representative receives \$750.00 towards their travel.

Conditions of Entry

I _____ accept the following Conditions of Entry:

Eligibility

1. Open to citizens or permanent residents of Australia.
2. Entrants must be female, aged **20-25 years** in the year of the Quest.
3. Previous entrants may not re-enter within 12 months of last Quest participation
4. Previous winners or runners-up may not re-enter.

Judging & Event Attendance

4. Attend final judging will take place during the **Nutrien Classic Event in Tamworth** (dates to be advised).
5. Attend presentations during the Nutrien Classic at AELEC Tamworth.
6. Entrants are responsible for their own **travel, accommodation, AELEC and associated expenses.**
7. Attendance is **compulsory on days to be determined by CLF- subject to Nutrien program and YAQ schedule.**
8. The **winner and runner-up** must remain in Tamworth for official duties as required.

Media & Promotion

9. Entrants authorise CLF to use **photographs, footage, and statements** for promotional purposes (including posters, online media, etc.).

Indemnity & Risk

10. Entry is at the **entrant's own risk.**
11. Entrants indemnify CLF, organisers, donors, sponsors, and prize providers against all claims, losses, suits, or demands arising from their actions.
12. Entrants waive their right to claim against CLF, organisers, sponsors, donors or judges in relation to injury, loss, or decisions.



Health & Safety

13. Entrants must exercise **reasonable care** to ensure the safety of themselves and others and comply with **Work Health & Safety rules**.
14. Entrants must disclose any **medical conditions, allergies, or dietary requirements**,
Plus provide an **emergency contact**.
15. Entrants must comply with CLF's **responsible consumption of alcohol policy**.
Use of illicit drugs or excessive alcohol is prohibited.

General Conditions

16. Failure to comply with any condition may result in **disqualification**.
17. The Quest program is subject to **change or cancellation** at any time (subject to CLF's obligations).
18. Entrants agree to **always abide by these Conditions**.
19. The **judges' decision is final**.
